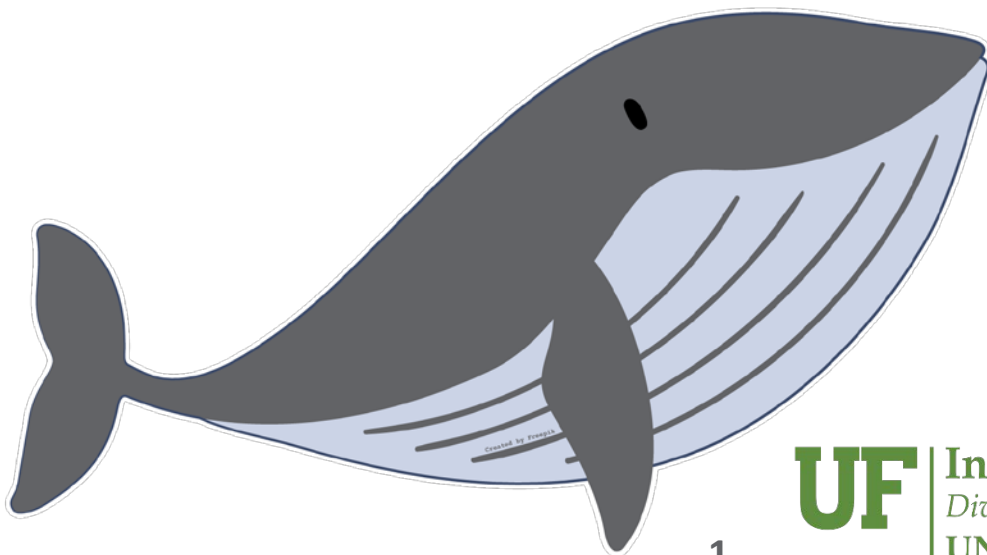

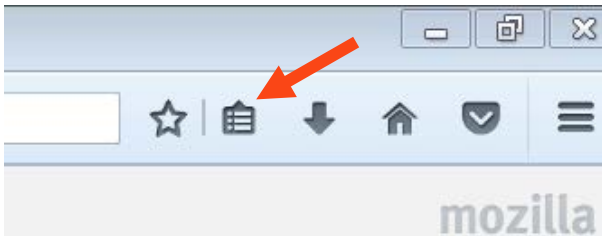

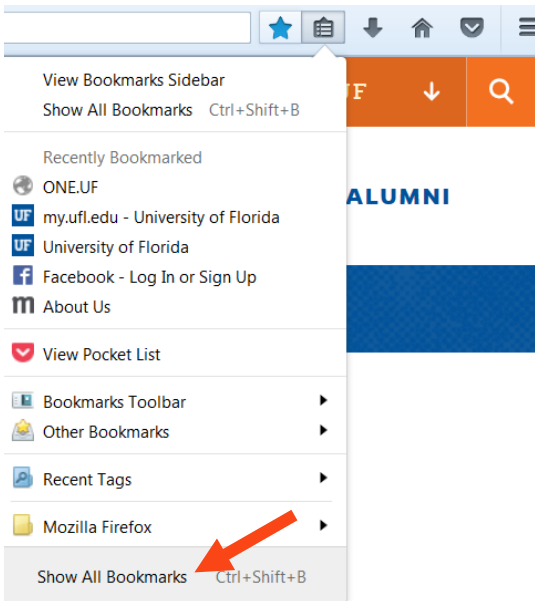
Exporting HTML Bookmarks

Firefox

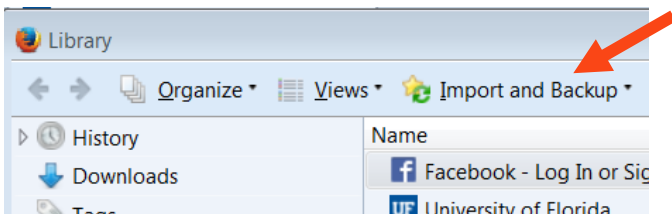
Step 1: Open Firefox and press the tab icon to view your bookmarks



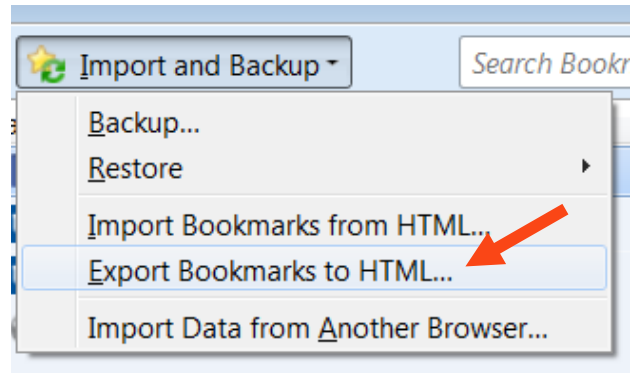
Step 2: Click “Show All Bookmarks” at the bottom



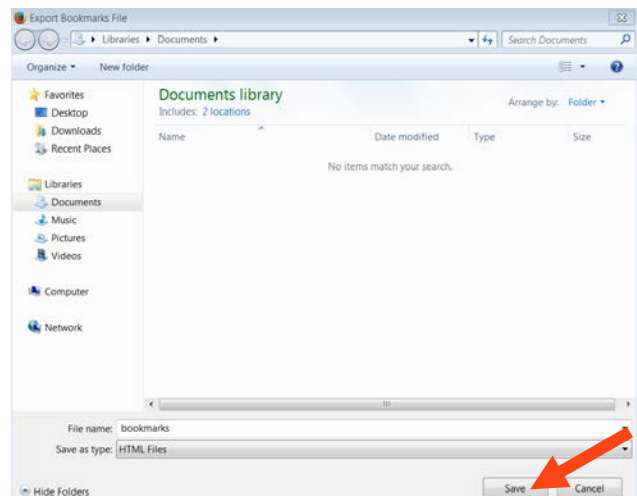
Step 3: Make sure all your bookmarks are located here. Press “Import and Backup”



Step 4: Press “Export Bookmarks to HTML...”



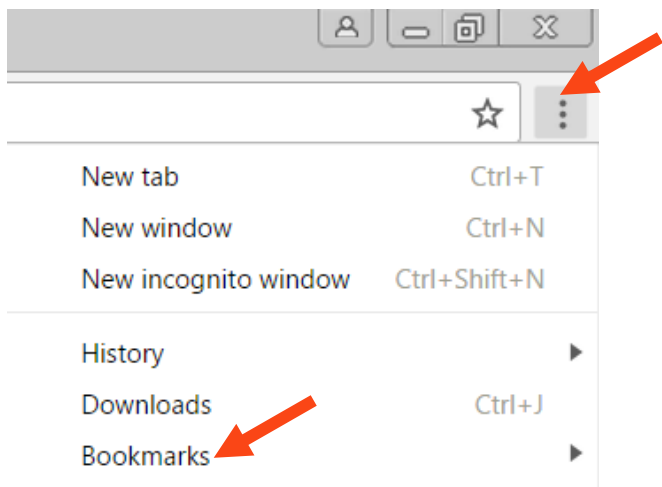
Step 5: Save your bookmarks in an HTML file in your personal network drive or department’s shared network drive so that you can access the file after the migration (i.e. “Gatorlink_FirefoxBookmarks”)



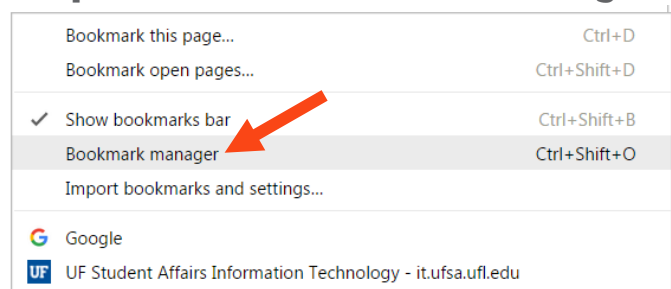
Exporting HTML Bookmarks

Chrome

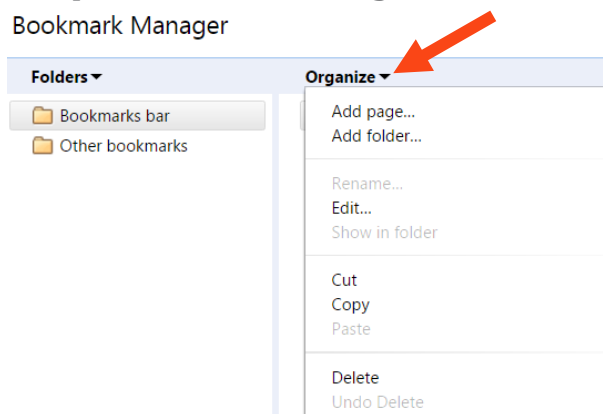
Step 1: Open Chrome menu bar and select “Bookmarks”



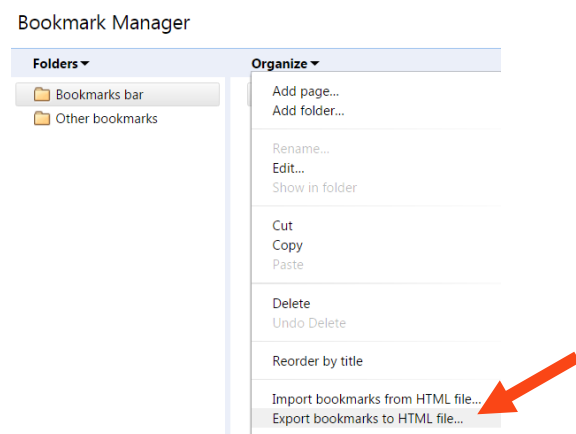
Step 2: Select “Bookmark Manager”



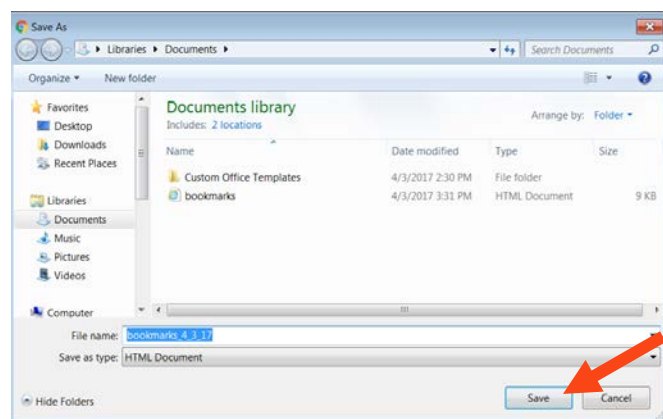
Step 3: Click on “Organize”



Step 4: Select “Export bookmarks to HTML file...”



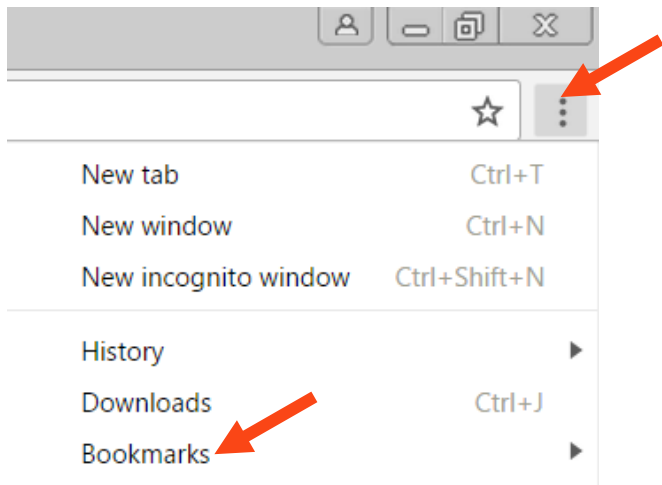

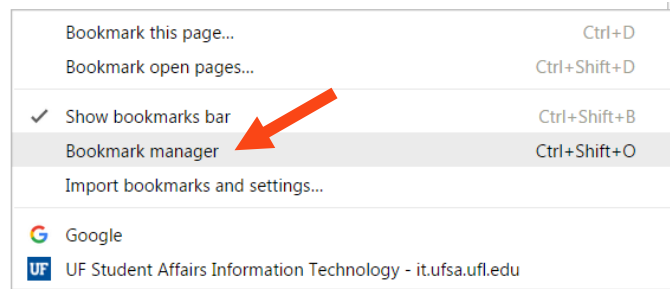
Importing HTML Bookmarks

Step 1: Open Chrome menu bar and select “Bookmarks.”

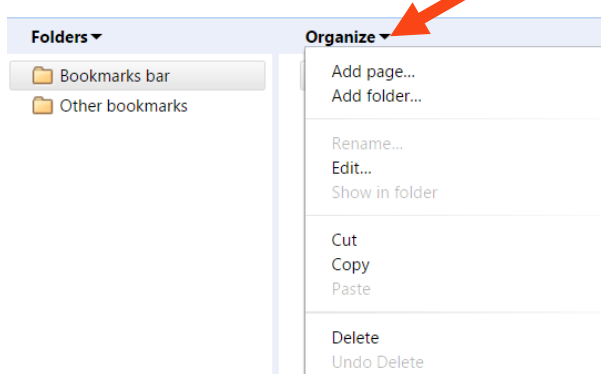


Step 2: Select “Bookmark Manager”



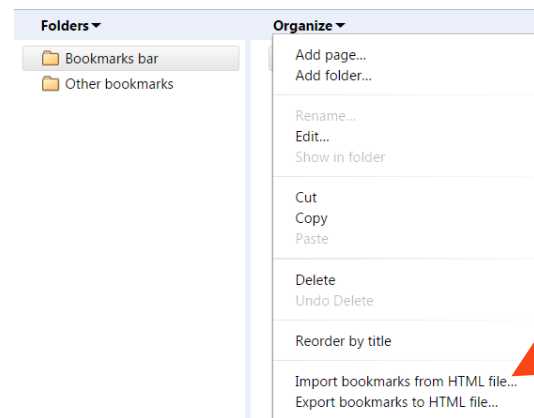
Step 3: Click on “Organize”

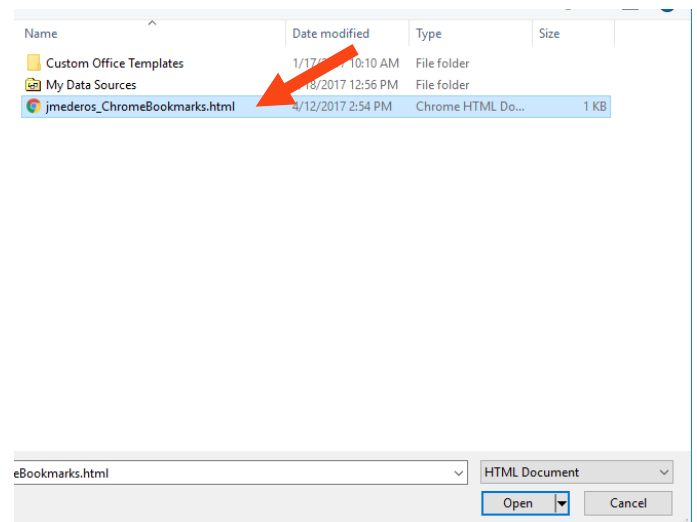


Step 4: Select “Import bookmarks from HTML file...”

Step 5: Go to where you saved your bookmarks before the migration (either your personal network drive or your department’s network drive) and double-click the HTML file to import

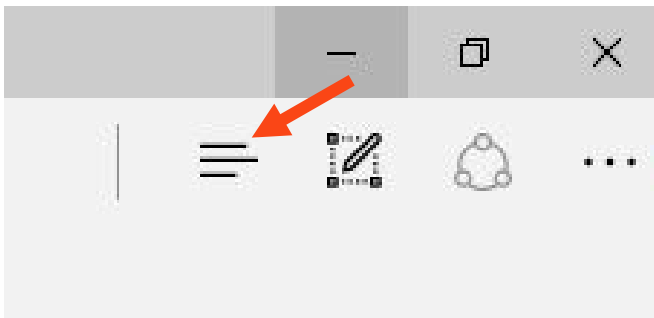


Importing HTML Bookmarks

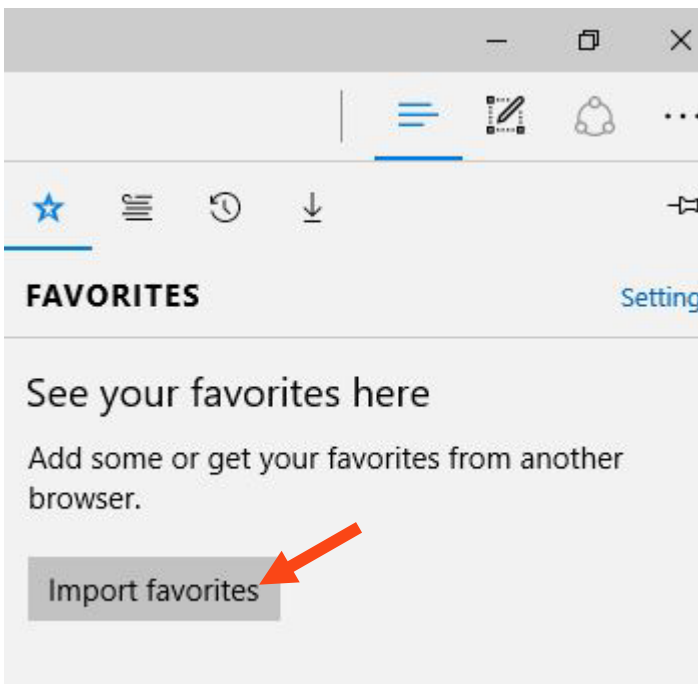
Edge

Before importing to Edge, you will need to follow the instructions on how to import your bookmarks to Chrome. When finished, follow these instructions:

Step 1: Open Edge and click on the favorites icon



Step 2: Click “Import Favorites”



Step 3: Select “Chrome” and click “Import”
