


Enrolling in UF Two-Factor Authentication

Step 1

Go to <https://it.ufl.edu/2fa/get-started/>

Read over and explore the “Get Started” page. It contains good information.



Click “Enroll Now” to get started...

Step 2

Be aware, once you click “Enroll Now” you will not be able to go back. At this point, you can still cancel enrollment.

You are about to Enroll in Two-Factor Authentication. Once you begin, BE SURE TO ADD AT LEAST ONE DEVICE NOW or your access to services may be interrupted with a call to the UF Computing Help Desk. Once you enroll, Two-Factor Authentication is enabled for your account to Two-Factor protected applications and environments.

Step 3

After reading what two-factor authentication is and how it will be used, click “Start setup.”

Two-factor authentication enhances the security of your account by using a secondary device to verify your identity. This prevents anyone but you from accessing your account, even if they know your password.

This process will help you set up your account with this added layer of security.

Step 4

Enter your device information:

What type of device are you adding?

- Mobile phone **RECOMMENDED**
- Tablet (iPad, Nexus 7, etc.)
- Landline
- U2F token

To install the application on your **mobile phone** or **tablet**, go to the app store on your device and search for DUO Mobile...

Step 7

After Installation, open Duo Mobile on your device.

Activate Duo Mobile for iOS




1. Open Duo Mobile.
2. Tap the "+" button.
3. Scan this barcode.


Click the + in the upper right corner. Hover over the QR code displayed on the webpage.

You really should add more than one device for your own benefit!



When you log into [any ufl.edu](#) webpage or application, you will be prompted to authenticate:



If you set your preferences above, it will automatically proceed with verification.

Pushed a login request to your device...

You can select cancel at any time and choose a different verification method or device.

Choosing "Call Me" will call your device, from (352) 392-4357. It will ask you to press 1 on your phone to log in.

If you choose "Passcode", you can click the Green Key inside the Duo Mobile App and it will show you a six digit code to enter on the webpage.
